


<p>Tenofovir Disoproxil fumarate/Mtricitabine (Teva)</p>  <p>(Generic available October 1, 2020)</p>	<p>The generic version of tenofovir disoproxil fumarate/emtricit-abine that can be taken once a day to help prevent HIV in-fection – this generic pill is also known as Truvada, see above.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> » Men who have sex with men » Trans women » Trans men » Heterosexual women and men » People who inject drugs » Adolescents aged 15 years and older 	<p>Some people may experience dizziness, nausea, headache and gas, which usually re-solves in the first few months of taking the medication.</p>	<p>N/A</p>	<p>iPrEX</p> <p>TDF2</p> <p>Partners PrEP</p> <p>The Bangkok Tenofovir Trial</p>
<p>Cabotegravir-long acting (LA) (Apretude 200mg)</p> 	<p>This injectable medication must be given at your providers office and can be given 2 different ways:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. An injection at month 1 and month 2 and then every two months 2. A month of medication in the pill form and then the infection is given at month 1 and month 2 and then every two months 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> » Men who have sex with men » Trans women » Cis gender women <p>Research is ongoing for adolescents (up to 17 years of age) who are born male at birth (includes men who have sex with men, transgender women, and gender nonconforming people and adolescents (up to 17 years of age) who are born female at birth.</p>	<p>Some people may experience mild to moderate injection site reactions, diarrhea, and headaches.</p>	<p>N/A</p>	<p>ECLAIR</p> <p>HPTN 083</p> <p>HPTN 084</p>
